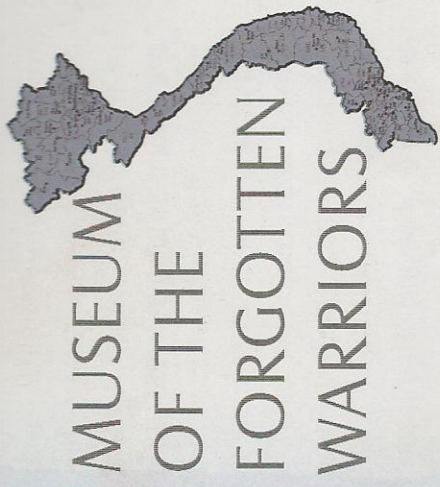
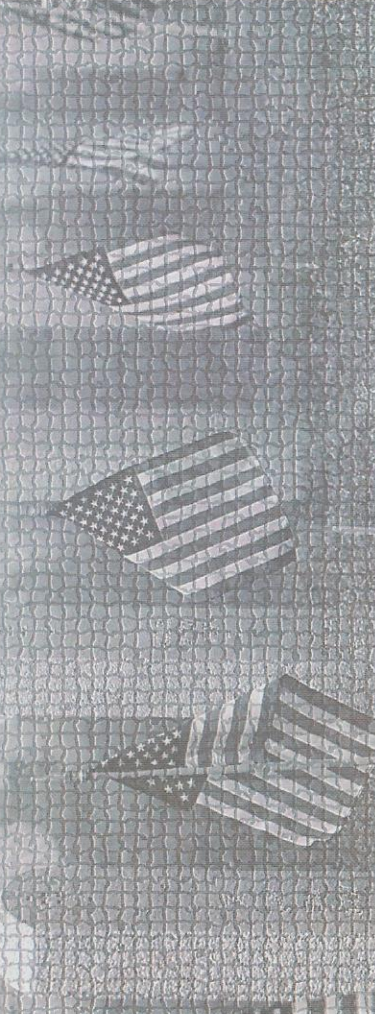

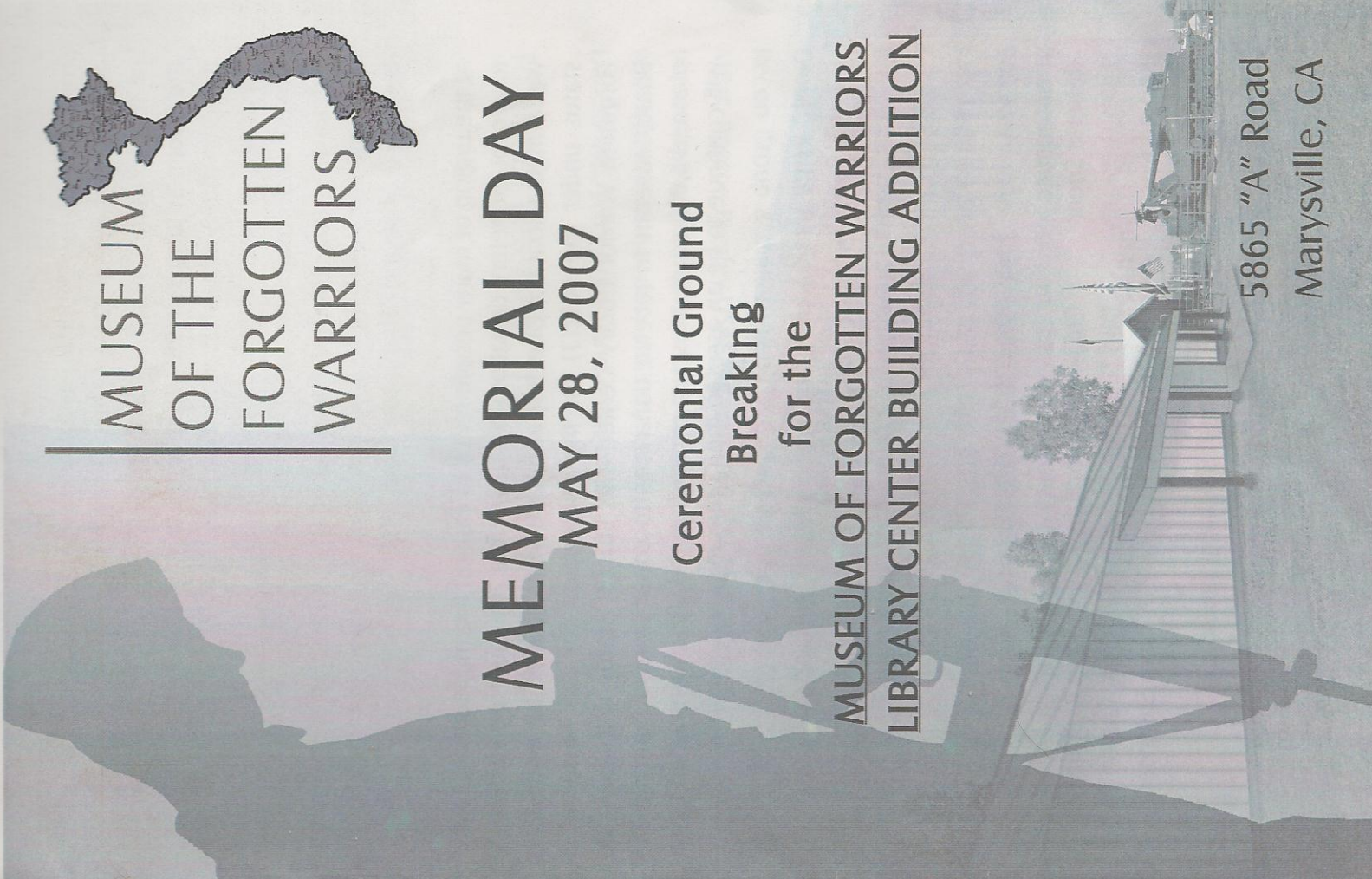

For 23 years, Roberta and I have expanded and maintained the Museum of the Forgotten Warriors. It opened to the public in January, 1985. Dedicated to those in the Vietnam War, it has been expanded 3 times to include those who served and fought in other wars and Veterans Groups. The museum was built by us to honor, remember and welcome home those who fought so they were not forgotten. It is our way of saying "Thank You" and "Welcome Home"!

At the urging of many people for us to expand the museum again and to accept monetary donations to insure that the museum continues, we formed a Board of Directors and have been granted tax exemption status under the 501c(3) for the corporation for the Museum of Forgotten Warrior Library Center. The 501c(3) status will allow the Board/Museum to receive donations to construct and maintain the planned 6,000 sq. ft. Museum expansion and Library Center so that it will continue to be an asset to the Community and Veterans.
