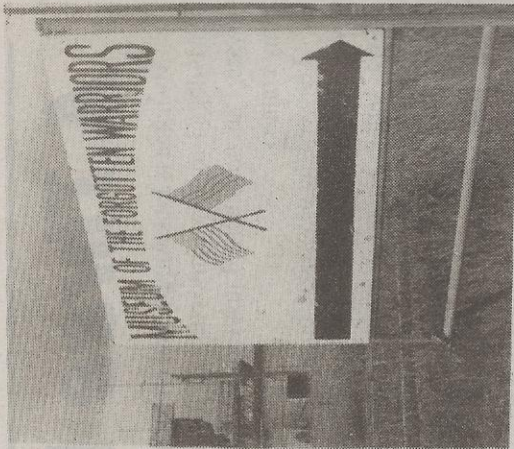




DANN SPEAR, CURATOR-FOUNDER of the Museum of Forgotten Warriors, holding a Smoke Grenade.



MUSEUM ENTRANCE SIGN, one mile west of Beale Air Force Base main gate on North Beale Rd.



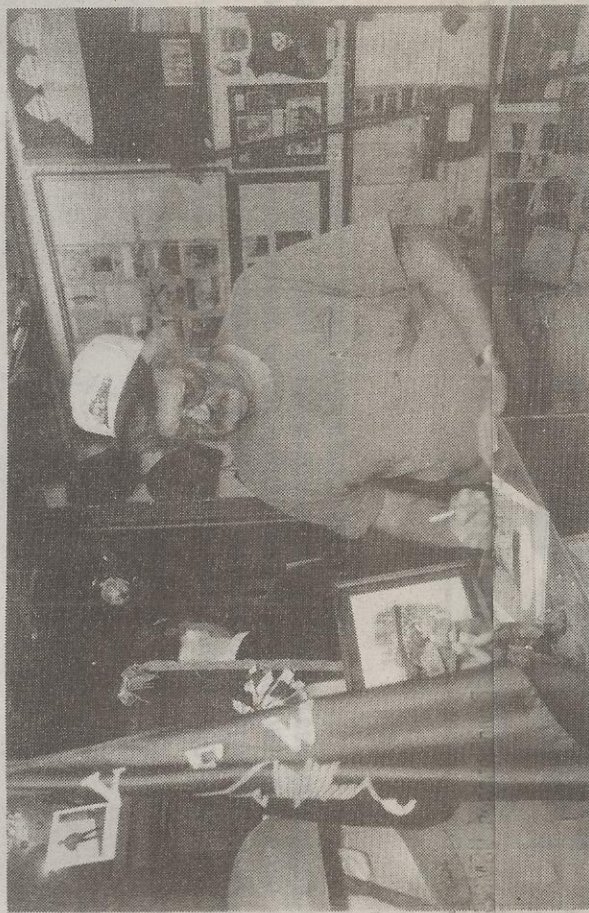
JACK HARTMAN of Live Oak, perched in the "Huey", flew "Night Hawk" in Nam, II Field Force.

HARLEY PARISH of Oliveturst holds an M-60 that he shouldered in Viet Nam with the 199th LIB LRRP.



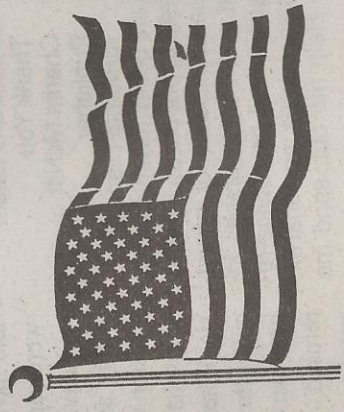
